Early Clinical Experience – HyperFlex®

Mean follow-up: 6 weeks

Key Outcomes

- Mean Total MOXFQ improvement: 20.3 points (38.0 → 17.7)
- Pain domain: Improved 28.6 points (46.1 → 17.5)
- Social domain: Improved 28.8 points (40.3 → 11.5)
- Mobility domain: Improved 9.6 points (31.0 → 21.4)
- 100% returned to shoes at 2 weeks

Pain and Social domain improvements are approximately twofold greater than published MCID thresholds (typically 12–16 points).

Mobility continues to be evaluated at later follow-up as postoperative swelling resolves.



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
